### STRICT COVID-19 Safety Policy

All clients visiting a restaurant must be fully vaccinated. Proof of vaccination status and photo ID will be required upon entry for every restaurant we visit.

Contact tracing will also be required. Your first and last name and phone number will be provided to the restaurant when your order is placed.

All volunteers, staff, and clients will need to wear a mask when riding in a vehicle. Masks will need to be worn in the restaurant anytime you are not in your seat.

We are following the rules put in place by public health. We are always here to offer friendly reminders and support.
