
an end. We are incredibly grateful for his contributions and positive impact. Thank you, Vibhas, for being an inspiring force of change!

New Donor Platform

During the pandemic, many charities struggled to do more with less. Inflation has hit food-based organizations disproportionately, and we continue to struggle to meet rapidly growing demand. Since 2019, we have doubled the number of residents we serve in East York.

To keep our costs low, our team has recently transitioned to a new donor platform called **Zeffy**. We have decided to change to save on fees companies like "Canada Helps" take for their service (+3% premium +transaction fees). With **Zeffy**, 100% of the donations pledged will flow directly to our charity, and to sustain their free platform, the decision to cover service fees is totally left to the donor.
