
Foot Care Clinic

Frozen Meals

With the cooler weather and flu season coming soon, we encourage you to put in an order for some frozen meals of your choosing to have on hand. Having meals delivered to your doorstep certainly beats going out to a grocery store, especially during these times.

NEW FROZEN ORDER DEADLINE

Effective immediately, the new deadline for clients placing a frozen order or editing an existing order for our Apetito and Rose Reisman suppliers, will need to be submitted by *Thursdays at NOON* for the following week delivery.

Breakfast Menu (Rose Reisman)

Orders placed by Thursday noon can be delivered as early as Tuesday of the following week. Should you have a hot meal or Apetito frozen order scheduled for later in the week and wish to receive your Rose Reisman order then, we can accommodate this, you just have to let our office know when you're placing the order. Otherwise, Tuesdays will be your presumed delivery day.

<u>Please note:</u> We have recently finished our first trial week of the frozen breakfast items from Rose Reisman. There are a few changes to be made going forward (mainly dealing with the packaging) in accordance with all of the feedback we received. Thank you for being patient with us. Enclosed is a list of the nutritional facts for the breakfast items being offered.
