Program Updates

Diners Club

Diners Club Clients,

We recognize that the last few years have been difficult for us as we navigated through the pandemic. Our team was overjoyed to restart Diners Club, albeit slowly this past Spring and we're working to add new restaurants and new programming to our rotation in the fall. We were excited to offer our lunches free of charge during the Spring and Summer months as a kind gesture to welcome you back. We are so glad to see our clients return to service, and even some fresh faces too!

We have heard directly from our partner venues that restaurants have also greatly suffered during the last three years and while they are excited to welcome us back, they've had no choice but to raise their prices. We have tried to delay passing this increase along to you for as long as we could, but we must raise our fees to \$12 per lunch effective September 1st, 2022.

Tipping also goes along way for the employees who take good care of us while our group is dining. Tipping is standard, and therefore strongly encouraged as our servers do a great job attending to our needs and requests. \$3 is the recommended tip amount, if you feel that you've been well served.

It is our goal to ensure Diners Club remains affordable to our clients. If the cost is unaffordable for you, we want to reassure you that subsidies will be made available to those who qualify. We may have to limit how many subsidies that we offer, so please reach out to our social worker Dawit at 416-424-3322 ext.2226 if you'd like to apply. We will ask you to provide proof of your most recent CRA issued Notice of Assessment as part of the subsidy approval process.

We thank you once again for joining us, and we hope to continue seeing you at our luncheons!
