Diners Club Updates

Meal Delivery Program Updates

We want to remind our clients that our price increase is in effect starting September 1st. Our Western/Chinese Hot Meals will increase to \$7 for regular portions and \$7.91 for extra portions. Frozen meals will be increased to \$43.35 per 7 entrees and \$6.56 per individual entree. The frozen dessert /soups will be increased to \$2.24.
