I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our very dedicated volunteers who have helped support EYMOW throughout the pandemic. We are so glad to share that 95% of our volunteers (and all employees) have received their first dose of the vaccine. Many of whom went to local clinics right here in East York.

At the beginning of April, the small business owners of 2 Thorncliffe Park Drive (2TPD) were contacted by Metrolinx about the Ontario Line project. Metrolinx plans on using this land as a storage shed and maintenance yard for their fleet of trains. All the while, community consultations have not occurred. We, along with many other family-run businesses and non-profits are at risk of being displaced as a result of this transit line. We are hopeful that we can change the course of their plan and continue to call this plaza our home. 
